Ordinance Reminder

(Section 2-402: WEEDS OR GRASSES; PUBLIC NUISANCE)

Section 2-404: WEEDS, GRASSES AND LITTER; NOTICE OF NON-COMPLIANCE

A. Whenever the Village Board determines that any grasses or weeds in excess of 12 inches, or 8 inches as described in Section 2-402, are growing on property within the village or litter is found on any property, notice to

abate and remove such nuisance shall be given by the village clerk as follows: (1) to each owner or owner's duly authorized agent by certified mail, which shall be conspicuously marked as to its importance; and (2) to the occupant, if any, by personal service by a village police officer or county sheriff or deputy.

B. Within five days after receipt of such notice, the owner or occupant of the lot or piece of ground may request a hearing with the village to appeal the decision to abate or remove the nuisance by filing a written appeal with the office of the village clerk. A hearing on the appeal shall be held within 14 days after the filing of the appeal and shall be conducted by the village chairman as hearing officer, who shall render a decision on the appeal within five business days after the conclusion of the hearing. If the appeal fails, the village may have such work done.
